**Overview:**

We are looking for creative, imaginative, technology-savvy Biigtigong Nishnaabeg, who want to make contributions to help improve the lives of children, to join us as we create our final proposal for Canada's Smart Cities Challenge (<http://biigtigong.com/language/smart-cities-gkendaasoo-gchi-oodenwan/>). As part of our team, we are hoping you will bring innovative and out of the box ideas that will contribute to us developing an amazing final proposal.

The Video Developer will be responsible for creating a series of educational and enjoyable videos for the membership. The education videos will support the overarching goals of the project by providing information that will empower our people. The Video Developer will be required to work collaboratively with other members of the team and the community.

**Responsibilities:**

- Actively make contributions to the vision and strategies of our Smart Cities Proposal, in order to improve our outcomes and facilitate success.
- Create and develop multimedia (audio/video) content for promotional and educational videos on specific topics (i.e. What is WaaWaa Immersion, Second Language Acquisition Theory, Why 12,000 hours?)
- Attend training sessions and follow up with assigned readings in order to become familiar with concepts and content requirements.
- Develop video scripts and storyboards for media projects.
- If necessary, plan video shoots, scout and select shoot locations.
- Record and edit video and sound projects, including selecting program format for final output, capturing/importing media, organizing raw media, editing footage and sound files, creating and inserting graphics, and adding music/voice overs.
- Develop an assessment process that includes a question and answer component with each educational video.
- Consult with stakeholders from production to post-production process.

**Qualifications:**

- Experience with audio and video recording and editing.
- Proficiency with digital editing systems and general production.
- Ability to learn new software programs.
- Must be able to work independently with little supervision.
- Ability to tell a story and have the watcher understand the content.

**Application Process:**

- All applicants will be asked to submit a one to two minute video presentation (using any software program).
- The video must contain an inspiring message and/or information relating to one or more of the following themes:
  - Biigtigong Nishnaabeg Identity
  - Elders
  - Children & Youth
  - Language
  - Land
  - Technology
  - Biigtig (the Pic River)
  - Aadsookaanan (our sacred stories)
