Biigtigong Nishnaabeg invites students from 15 to 30 years of age coming from school and returning in the fall to apply.

Under the Supervision of the Culture and Heritage Manager, the Traditional Knowledge Keeper's duties will include:

- Assist in the projects related to the cultural and heritage preservation;
- Participate in the data collection of traditional knowledge to support community culture and identity;
- Assist in the development of language projects and programs including the Aadsokaanan project (traditional oral story telling)
- Research and document community history and stories
- Interact and interview community elders
- Participate in territory projects such as traditional place names
- Attend the annual canoe trip to document territory history

Requirements:

- Friendly, energetic and engaging personality
- Excellent oral communication and writing skills
- Motivated, takes initiative and requires little supervision as an individual and in a team setting
- Positive attitude and ability to interact and engage with staff, public and community
- Willingness and be comfortable working outdoors and inclement weather and conditions (heat, rain, bugs, etc.)
- Willingness to learn, take on new challenges and be mentored

Applicants are required to submit resume and cover letter, transcripts, student information form, consent to release of information form, and verification of returning to school.
