



Emergency Response Team Update

After discussion with the Education Director and team, the Emergency Response Team is supporting the reopening of the school and Children & Family Learning Center at 50% in person programming effective Wednesday, February 3, 2021. The one major change will be that children in grade 1 and up will now be required to wear a mask, as well, masks will be required when social distancing is not possible outside.

We want to remind community residents that all other conditions of the State of Emergency and Stay at Home order remain in effect.

The following conditions still apply:

Everyone is asked to stay home and avoid non-essential trips and outings. Outside gatherings with people outside your household cannot be greater than 5 people.

Essential trips are defined for the purpose of:

- Grocery shopping
- Pharmacy needs
- Medical appointments

The Gym remains closed. The community rink remains open to one family household at a time.
