## Have you ever thought about working for Parks Canada?

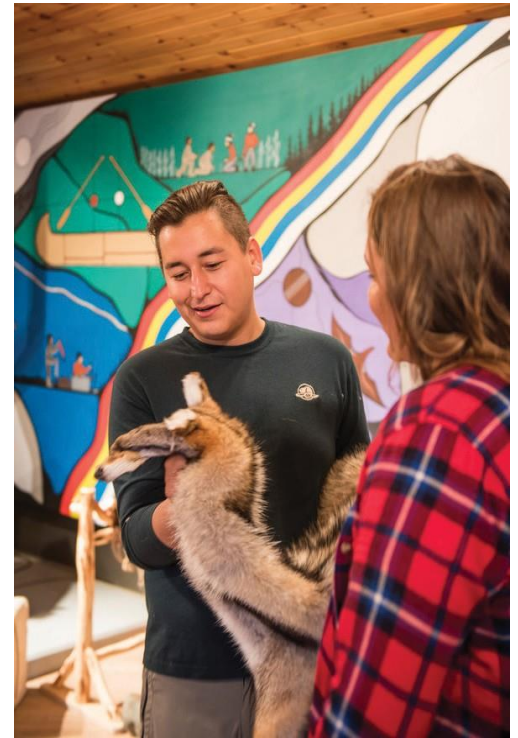
Get a behind-the-scenes look at how the park operates by working for Visitor Experience, Assets, and General Operations at Pukaskwa National Park.

### Visitor Experience Team (2 positions):

Help visitors meaningfully connect with and develop an appreciation for Pukaskwa National Park at the park kiosk or the beautiful Hattie Cove Visitor Centre. Assist with operations in the park store, answering visitor questions and interpretive programs.

**Assets Team (2 positions):** Provide grounds and facility maintenance services in Hattie Cove, including building cleaning and maintenance, garbage, and recycling, as well as some front country trail clearing and maintenance.

**General Operations (1 position):** Help with a variety of different tasks by rotating through different functional teams. Participate in field projects studying rare plants and animals, learn about the Visitor Safety program, assist in delivering interpretive programs and answering visitor questions, and provide grounds and facility maintenance services.

- Knowledge of the natural and cultural history, programs, and/or facilities of Pukaskwa National Park

### **Abilities:**

- Ability to communicate clearly, giving clear information to the public, supervisors, and co-workers

- Ability to follow directions

### **Essential Qualifications:**

- Interest in the outdoors and Pukaskwa National Park
- Willing to work a variable schedule, including evenings, weekends, and statutory holidays
- Willingness to get your hands dirty, and work in wet, sometimes cold, and buggy conditions
